Art. 1 – COURSE ACTIVATION

As a part of Horizon 2020 “Leading Towards Sustainable Gender Equality Plans in research performing organizations - LeTSGEPs” - Grant Agreement n. 873072, the Department of Economics of the University of Messina opens the selection for 20 positions for the admission to the INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL on “Gender Budgeting and Gender Equality measurement”, activated for the academic year 2022/2023.

The Summer School will take place in Messina, Italy from 28 to 30 June 2023.
The official language of the Summer School is English.

Art. 2 - EDUCATIONAL GOALS

The Summer School is open to PhD students and early stage researchers from different backgrounds, with research interests and experience in gender discrimination, gender mainstreaming, gender budgeting, gender equality plan, gender equality measurement, sustainability and social reporting.

The program allows young students to explore these issues with a practical approach based on analysis and interpretation through case studies and simulations.

Lectures, teamwork and mentoring spaces will be provided to advance participants' knowledge in the main research topics of the school.

Art. 3 - TARGET AUDIENCE AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The School is open to PhD students and early stage researchers holding a PhD for less than 8 years.

An excellent knowledge of the English language (C1) is required.

The aforementioned requisites must be met on the expiry date of the deadline for the presentation of the applications.

Art.4 - ADMISSION REQUEST

Those who intend to compete for admission to the Summer School must submit an application to info@letsgeps.eu , indicating in the subject of the email "**Summer School Unime Application**".

The **deadline** for submitting applications is **15 March 2023 at 12:00 a.m.**

The commission will communicate the names of the admitted participants by email by **20 March 2023**.

The following documents must be attached to the application, in electronic format, under penalty of ineligibility for the course:

- Completed application form (you can find it to the following link <http://bit.ly/3HqRSDC>)
- Updated curriculum vitae in Europass format, stating research interests and knowledge of quantitative and qualitative research methods
- Valid identity document
- Self-certification of knowledge of the English language at least at level C1
- Motivational letter
- Document attesting the status of PhD students or early stage researchers holding a PhD for less than 8 years

Applications received late or in a manner other than that indicated in this article, whatever the reason, will not be taken into consideration.

Forgery in deeds and false declarations are punished pursuant to the Italian Penal Code and the special laws on the subject, Articles 75 and 76 of the Presidential Decree. 445/2000.

Art.5 – ADMISSION TO THE SCHOOL AND COSTS

The limited number of participants to the School is established in 20.

Since the Summer School is supported by the funds of the Horizon LeTSGEPs project 8 positions are reserved to applicants of the project partners (UNIMORE, RWTH, MISANU, UNIME, UT, MPG, ICM, CY) who meet the requirements indicated in Article 3.

The selection procedure to be admitted to the school will be based upon CV and motivation letter.

There will be no fees to access the Summer School. Travel and accommodation costs remain the responsibility of the participants.
