In 2023, the governance, heads of research and administrative departments participated in awareness workshops to prevent and address gender-based violence, harassment, and discrimination on campus.

The recognition of the importance of the intersection of gender with other identities has been sealed by the appointment of a Diversity and Inclusion Manager.

Since 2020, research on gender issues has been promoted through recurrent seminars, and workshops at CY, as well as in collaborating institutions.
